Maths

Mastering number curriculum

Pupils will continue to develop their subitising and counting skills and explore the composition of numbers within and beyond 5.

They will begin to identify when two sets are equal or unequal and connect two equal groups to doubles.



Literacy

To retell stories.

To recognise most taught sounds, including digraphs.

To segment/blend CV/CVC words and some CVCC/CCVC words.

To recognise some tricky words – eg I, the, go, no, to.

To write own name with letters accurately formed

To be able to form most letters accurately and to write CVC words independently

To begin to understand the structure of sentence



Understanding the world

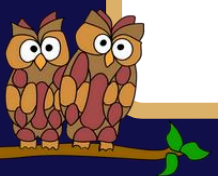
Know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now drawing on their experiences and what has been read in class.

Understand the past through settings, characters and events encountered in books read in class and storytelling.

Begin to understand that things happened before they were born.

Use books/resources to learn about the past.
